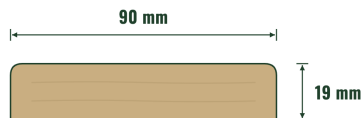

Merbau decking board, nominal dimensions

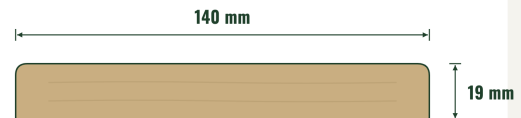

02 Product overview

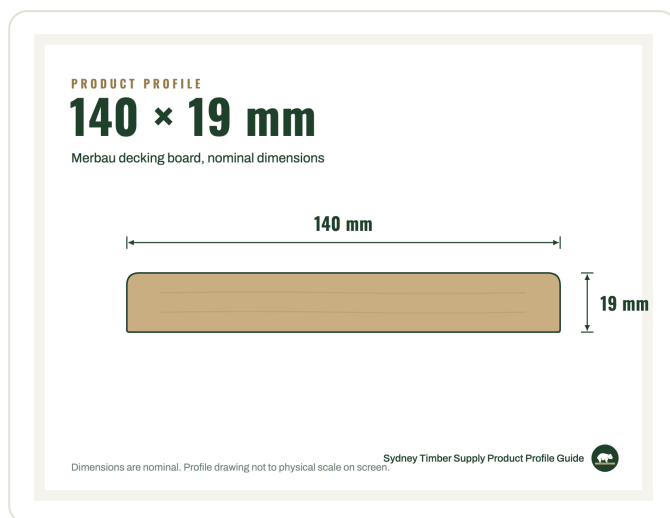
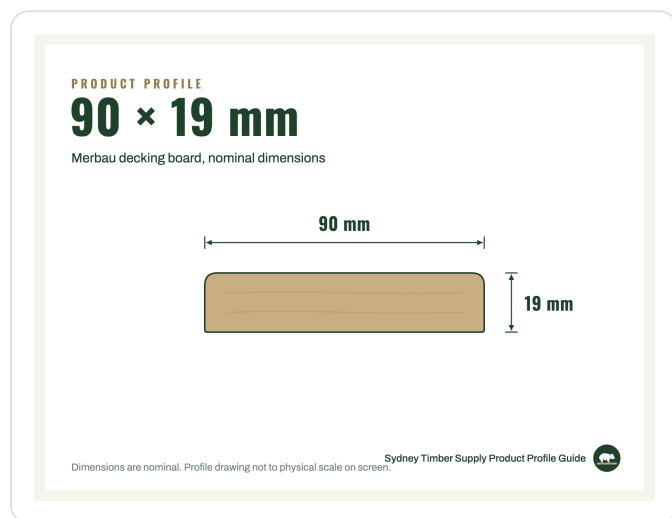
Merbau is the most widely stocked decking hardwood in the Sydney retail market and the standard entry point for buyers wanting a hardwood deck at the more accessible end of the hardwood price range. The supplier lists Class 2 durability for Merbau decking.

Merbau is stable, easy to work and weathers to a deep reddish brown. It is an imported hardwood: it is not Australian grown and does not carry the Class 1 rating of our Australian range.

04 Ordering

Pricing	Priced per linear metre (LM). The current rate is shown on the product page; quantities are entered as linear metres.
Lengths	Random lengths are supplied. Preferred individual lengths can be requested by quote and are confirmed against current supplier availability.
Packs and trade	Pack quantities, set-length packs where published, and trade volumes are quoted. Use the quote form on the product page or call us.
Pickup and delivery	Pickup from West Gosford NSW. Delivery is quoted per order based on load size, board length and site access.



05 Installation and handling

- Store boards flat, fully supported and off the ground, and keep them dry before installation. Allow the timber to acclimatise at the site before fixing.
- Fix with hot dipped galvanised or stainless steel screws, two per joist, pre-drilled and countersunk. Stainless steel fixings are recommended for coastal or poolside work.
- Maintain ventilation gaps between boards and adequate ground clearance so the deck can dry out; the supplier installation guidelines on the product page set out clearances in detail.
- Use sharp, quality cutting tools and seal cut ends with decking oil. Wear appropriate eye, ear and breathing protection when cutting.

06 Care and maintenance

- Clean the surface before coating; an oxalic acid based timber cleaner removes dirt, grease and tannin stains.
- Finish with a penetrating decking oil per the coating manufacturer's label, then re-coat on a regular cycle suited to exposure and traffic.
- Monitor the coated timber for colour loss and dryness, and re-coat when it begins to look dry to maintain protection.
